



SHELF WITH BRACKETS

BEFORE INSTALLING

Read the entire Installation Instructions.
Observe all local building and safety codes.

INSTRUCTIONS

Unpack and inspect the product for any shipping damages and ensure that none of the required pieces are missing. If you find damages, do not install. Contact Customer Service at 1.866.855.2284. If you need assistance or have questions while installing your shelf and brackets, contact Customer Service.

We recommend consulting a professional if you are unfamiliar with installing hardware fixtures. Signature Hardware accepts no liability for any damage to the brackets, shelf, or wall, or for personal injury during installation.

Stud Finder

INSTALLATION

1. Locate and mark the location of the studs to which you will fasten your shelf bracket. You can find studs by listening for a solid sound as you knock on the wall or by using a stud finder.

Tip: If the studs in your bathroom do not line up to the mounting location for your brackets, wood blocking can be installed between the studs using standard 2 x 4's. We recommend consulting a professional if you are unfamiliar with this type of installation.

2. Hold the brackets up in the mounting location and mark the location of the mounting holes.

3. Use a level and tape measure to ensure the brackets are lined up properly.

4. Drill pilot holes in the locations marked in the previous steps with the appropriate drill bit for your mounting hardware.

5. Attach the brackets to the wall with the mounting hardware.

6. Place shelf on brackets. For additional security, insert screws through the brackets into the bottom of the shelf.

Note: This option may not work with all shelf materials; do not insert screws if this will damage your shelf.
